

Download Guideline for Fruits Multi-Coin Web Wallet (Beta Version)



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⚠ Warning

- Before updating your wallet, please make sure you have your current wallet address passphrase in a safe and secure location
- It is your responsibility to have it copied and secured because just like any other cryptocurrency wallet, we do not have access to your wallet



Update Explanation

- This update divides the Fruits Wallet Addresses into 2 types
 - 1) FRUITS-Only Wallet
 - 2) FRUITS Multi-Coin Wallet
- The old wallet address will automatically become a “FRUITS-Only Wallet”, so if you are a user who is logged out from their account then please make sure to import your FRUITS-Only Wallet.
- Users are also required to “create account” in order to have access to the new FRUITS Multi-Coin Wallet where you will be able to have access to Bitcoin (BTC) & Ethereum (ETH)



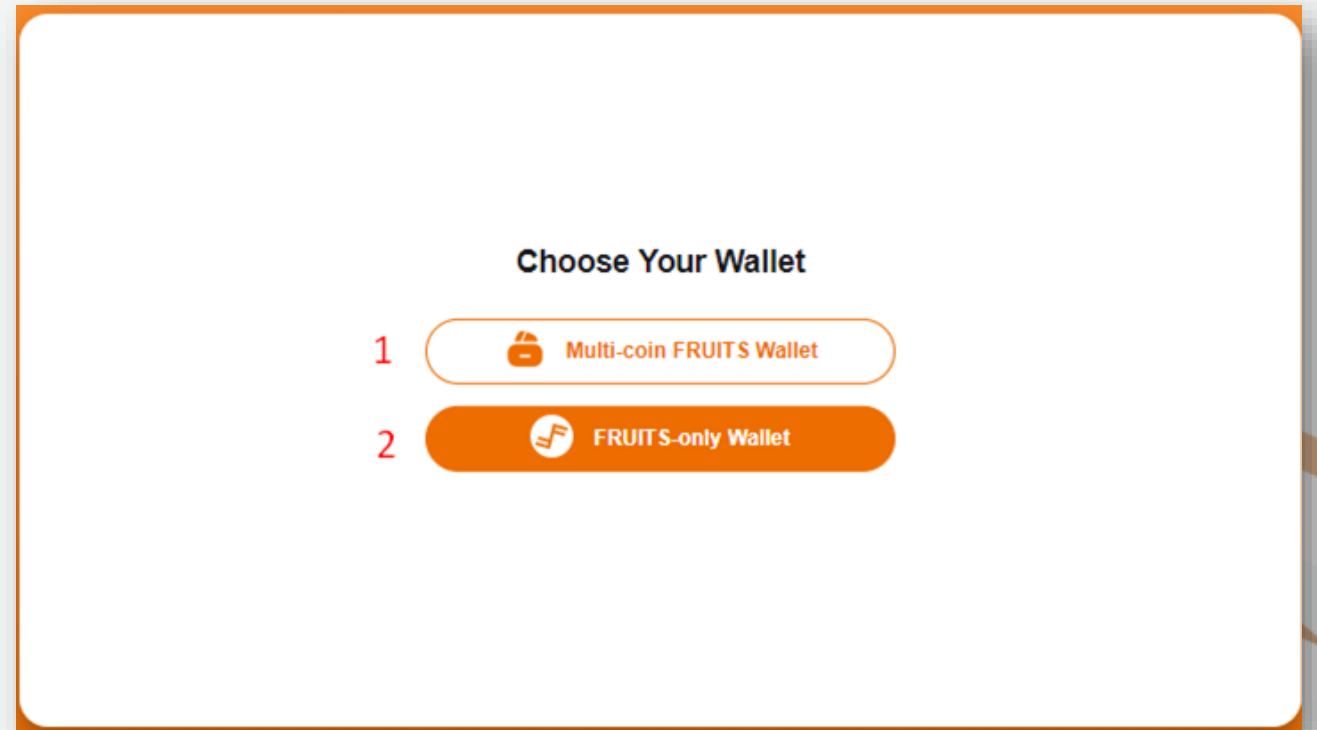
Choose Your Wallet

Step 3

- Click “Multi-coin FRUITS Wallet”

Note

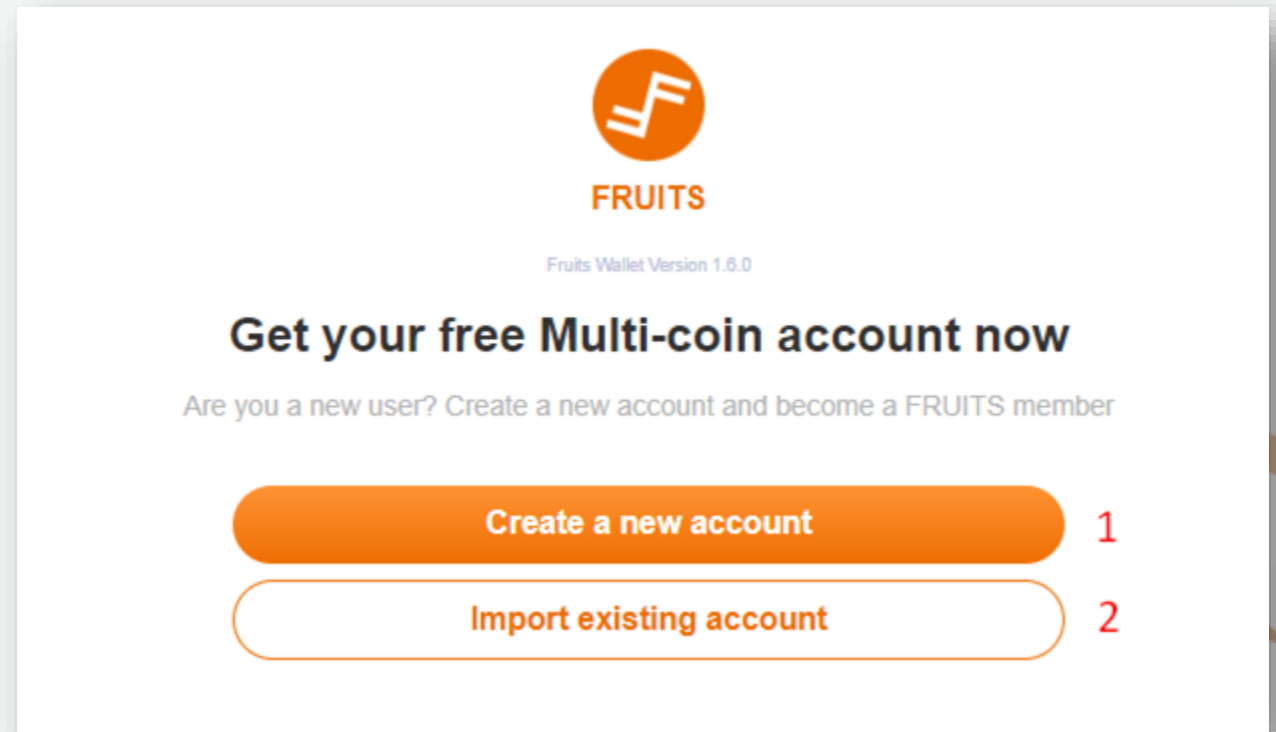
- Starting this update, the system will stop supporting users from creating a FRUITS-only wallet account and instead users will need to create a multi-coin wallet to manage their coins
- If the user already has a FRUITS-only wallet, please use the “Import only FRUITS account” to import your account



FRUITS Multi-Coin Wallet Account

Step 4

- If you do not have a Fruits Multi-Coin Wallet Account, click the “Create a new account” button
- If you already have a Fruits Multi-Coin Wallet Account, click the “Import existing account” button



Register – tab “Secure”

Step 5

- Move your cursor around (1) to seed the random number generator and create a secure passphrase
- Move your cursor until the bar (2) is full

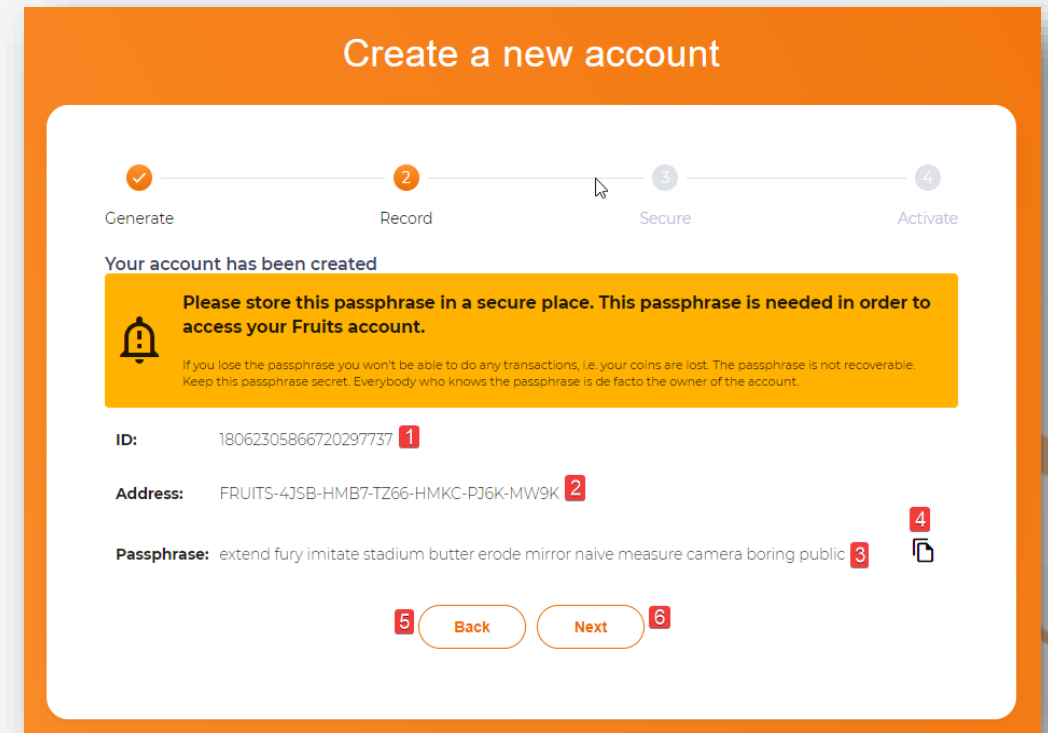
Register – tab “Record”

Step 6

- Your “Wallet ID” is automatically generated
- Your “Wallet Address” is automatically generated
- Your “Passphrase” is automatically generated
 - Remember "Passphrase" to login to the wallet address
 - Note & Store somewhere SAFE

Step 7

- Click ICON (4) to copy “Passphrase” to your PC's clipboard
- Click the “Next” button



Register – tab “Secure

Step 8

- Enter PIN is required field
 - Needs to be at least 4 characters
 - Your PIN is used in all transactions

Step 9

- Click the “Next” button
- The “Next” button is only enabled when you have entered at least 4 characters in the “Enter PIN” section

- The “Finish” button will be enabled once you have clicked on all the words
